

| What to do if...  | Action needed  | Return to school when...   |
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| If you have any Covid-19 symptoms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ high temperature</li> <li>○ a new <u>continuous</u> cough</li> <li>○ a loss or change to sense of smell or taste</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Do not come to school.</li> <li>▪ Contact school to inform us. Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days.</li> <li>▪ Get a test.</li> <li>▪ Inform school immediately of the test result.</li> </ul>   | ... you feel better <u>and</u> at least 10 days have passed since symptoms started, even if you still have a cough or a loss/change in sense of taste or smell. These symptoms may last for several weeks after recovery from illness.     |
| If you test positive for Covid-19   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Do not come to school</li> <li>▪ Contact school to inform us. Agree an earliest date for possible return to school (minimum of 10 days from day after when symptoms started).</li> <li>▪ Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days.</li> </ul>   | ... you feel better <u>and</u> at least 10 days have passed since the symptoms started, even if you still have a cough or a loss/change in sense of taste or smell. These symptoms may last for several weeks after recovery from illness. |
| If you test negative for Covid-19   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Contact the school.</li> <li>▪ Discuss when you can come back to school.</li> </ul>   | ... the test comes back negative <u>and</u> you feel well and are clear of any other signs of illness, and the School has given you confirmation.  |
| If you are ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Do not come to school</li> <li>▪ Follow usual school absence procedure</li> </ul>   | ... you are recovered, as usual.   |
| Someone in your household has Covid-19 symptoms   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Do not come to school</li> <li>▪ Contact school to inform us. Household member to get tested, and the whole household should self-isolate until the result comes.</li> <li>▪ Inform school immediately of the test result.</li> </ul>   | ... the test comes back negative and you feel well and is free of any signs of illness.  |
| Someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Do not come to school</li> <li>▪ Contact school to inform us. Agree an earliest date for possible return to school (minimum of 14 days from day after when household member's symptoms started).</li> <li>▪ Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days.</li> </ul>                              | ... you have completed 14 full days of isolation   |
| NHS Test & Trace identifies that you have been in close contact with someone with Covid-19  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Do not come to school</li> <li>▪ Contact school to inform us. Agree an earliest date for possible return to school (minimum of 14 days).</li> <li>▪ The individual contacted by Test &amp; Trace should maintain distance from other household members as far as possible for 14 days.</li> </ul> | ... you have completed 14 full days of isolation   |

Where a case is confirmed, the information should be conveyed to the Covid 19 Return Team, who will take advice from Public Health England. Students can still undertake teaching and learning via online.
