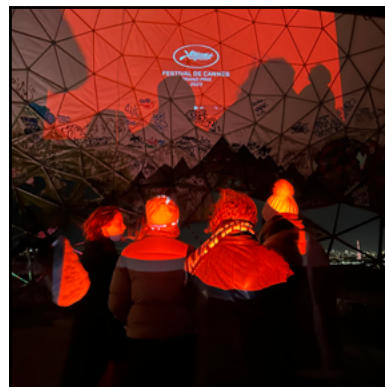

A truly invaluable aspect of your time at MetFilm School is the **NETWORK** of likeminded creatives that you have the opportunity to build.

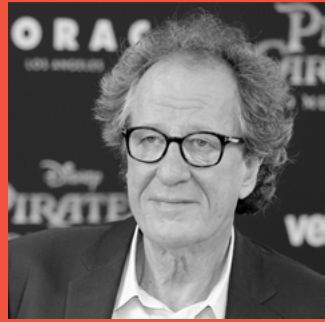

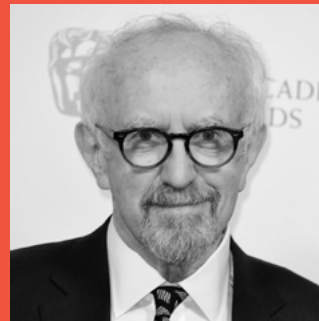

Transport for London (TfL) offers a 'Student Travelcard'. This card carries a 30% discount for all full time BA & MA students over 18.





Berlin is one of Europe's most visited cities – and it's a place that people look to for the latest trends in art and culture.

Constantly on the forefront of creative innovation, Berlin hosts over 50 film festivals every year, representing the artistic, cultural, and social diversity of the city.

Berlin's Film Festivals include...

- **Berlinale:** A top international festival held alongside the European Film Market.
- **Human Rights Film Festival:** A forum for discussing storytelling in the context of human rights, activism & empowerment.

Moving to Berlin?

MetFilm School Berlin students are eligible for a discounted monthly fare on Germany's public transportation (approx. €58/month).





Leeds has been described as 'big city life' without the London prices. Home to five universities, the city has a massive student population – and this is reflected in every aspect of the social experience here.

Leeds Rail Station offers services to London, Newcastle, Edinburgh, and more, and is only a 15-minute drive from our campus.

Why not explore the local markets...

- **Kirkgate Market:** A variety of food, fashion, jewellery and miscellaneous homewares.
- **Briggate Farmers' Market:** Freshly baked brownies, pastries, and local fruit & veg.

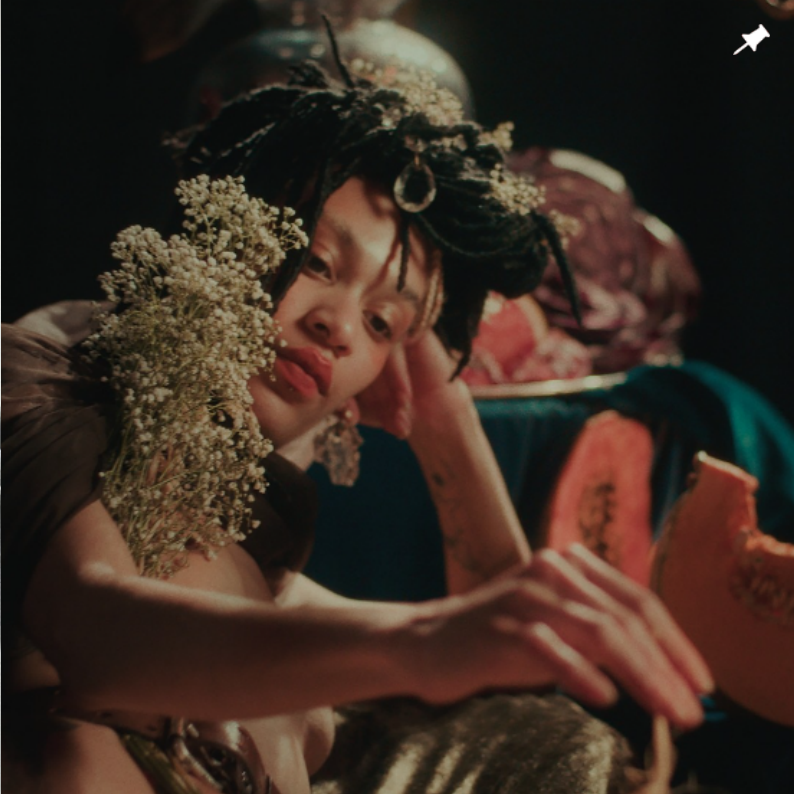
